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The tulip has been interpreted in fabric for centuries. This modern version makes a lovely spring table runner is the perfect project for your Spring or Easter Table!

Finished Size: 18" x 52"

Fabric Requirements

Yellow – 6" square scrap or larger
Pink – Fat Quarter
Green – Fat Quarter
White – 1 yd for top
Backing – 1 yd pieced
¼ yard – binding
24" x 56" batting

Cutting Directions

Yellow

6 – 2" squares (Y1)

Pink

3 – 4 ½ squares (P1)
6 – 3 ½ x 6 ½ (P2)

Green

6 – 2 ½ x 6 ½ (G1)
6 – 2 ½ x 8 ½ (G2)

White

3 – 4 ½ squares (W1)
6 – 3 ½ squares (W2)
6 – 2 x 3 ½ (W3)
6 – 2" squares (W4)
12 – 2 ½ squares (W5)
2 – 2 ½ x 8 ½ (W6)
6 – 8 ½ squares (W7)
2 – 2 ½ x 18 ½ (W8)

General Directions and Abbreviations

Please read all directions prior to cutting and assembly

WOF – Width of Fabric
LOF – Length of Fabric
RST – Right Sides Together
HST – Half Square Triangles

All seams are ¼" wide and small arrows indicate pressing direction

Binding

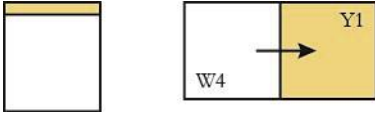
160" x 2" binding or 4 – 2" x WOF

Backing

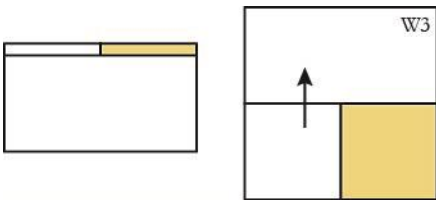
(Pieced) 22" x LOF then stitch remaining back to 36" to obtain 54" + inches

Assembly of the Tulip Blocks – Make 6

With RST join a (W4) square with a (Y1) square. Unit should measure 2" x 3 1/2". Complete all 6 before going to the next step.



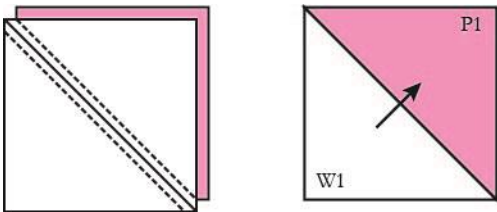
With RST, join the unit from above with a W3 rectangle as shown. Unit now measures 3 1/2" x 3 1/2". You should have 6 units.



Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the W1 squares.

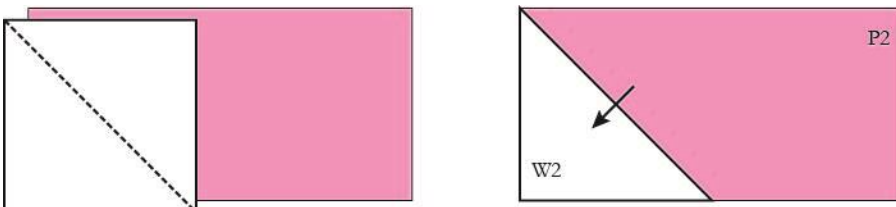
With RST, join a W1 square with a P1 square.

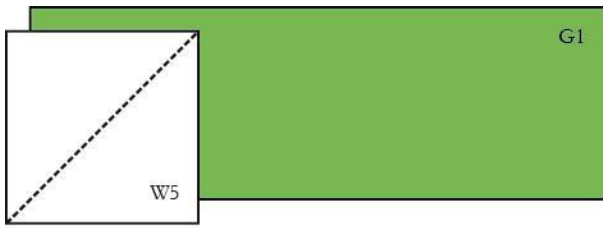
Stitch 1/4" from each side of the drawn line. Cut on diagonal line. Press towards the pink side. Trim to 3 1/2" square. Repeat to make 6 half square triangles.



Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of all 6 – W2 squares.

With RST, join a W2 square with a P2 rectangle (see diagram) stitch on the drawn line. Press towards the white. Trim excess away Make 6 units. They should measure 3 1/2" x 6 1/2".





Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of 12 – W5 squares

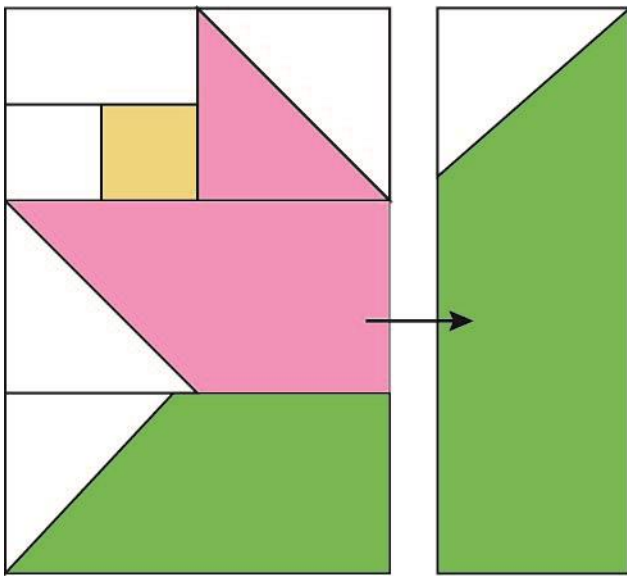
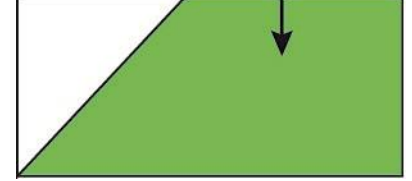
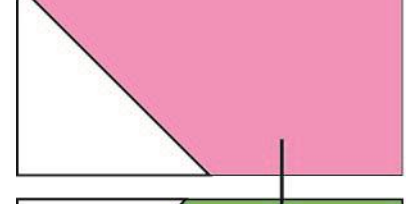
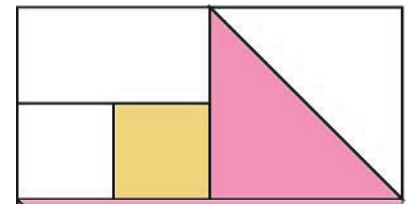
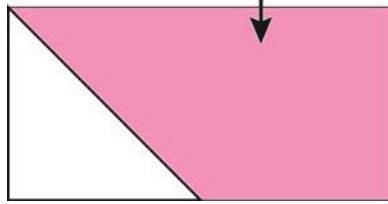
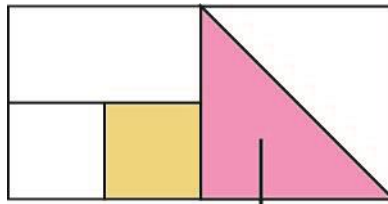
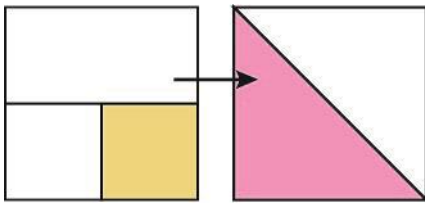
With RST, join a W5 square with a G1 rectangle (See diagram). Stitch on the drawn line. Press towards the white and trim the excess away. Make 6 units. Units should measure $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ ".



With the 6 remaining W5 squares, join RST with G2 rectangle as shown. Stitch on diagonal line. Press towards white, and trim excess. Make 6 units. Units measure $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ ".



Join the units as shown.



Complete the table runner as shown below.

Quilt and Bind as Desired.
